If we can keep The First Commandment, we can keep them all, if we break any other Commandment we break the First Commandment as we have another 'god.' Share what is being fear, loved and trusted above God when people break these commandments. FIRST COMMANDMENT AND MEANING: When a person has an idol in their heart, they fear, love and trust; When a person swears with God's name they fear, love and trust; When a person doesn't attend public worship they fear, love and trust; When a person doesn't respect or obey authority, they fear, love and trust; When a person harms or kills another person, they fear, love and trust; When a person commits adultery and is sexually immoral; When a person steals or doesn't do their best they fear, love and trust; When a person gossips or lies about someone else, they fear, love and trust; When a person is jealous and covets something or someone else, they fear, love and trust; CLOSING: Pray, "I am trusting thee Lord Jesus, trusting only thee, trusting thee for full salvation great and free. Lord to whom shall we go, you have the words of eternal life. Amen."
