ST. JOHN LUTHERAN CHURCH CONFIRMATION THE APOSTLES' CREED Lesson 15: "The Apostles' Creed, Part 2," (L15) Year 1 (7th Grade)

After completing this lesson, the student will:

*Know Who God the Father is.

*Know the truth about angels.

*Can share three things that make humans unique.

*Can identify two characteristics of demons/evil angels.

*Can share what "Ex Niholo" means and What God used to create all.

1. Introduction:

Watch video: (Parents are to meet with students during instruction with this commandment).

- 2. Select one triangle chosen for God the Father, be certain that they write on it that "The Father Creates." Add to that "God the Father" Triangle" as you deem fit over this class.
- 3. Get a watch, hold it up. Ask students, "Where did this come from? The store, a gift, etc.. Ask where did the store get it? How was the factory able to make it? Keep pushing the students back to the point that there needs to be material and most importantly design and intelligence. Ask if they would believe that it evolved on the ocean shore due to the constant pounding of the waves over billions of years? Ask, "What is more complex, our body or the watch? Share God the Father is the intelligent designer of all life.
- 4. Write out "<u>The First Article</u> "<u>Creation</u>," found on pp. 108-109 in <u>The Small Catechism</u>, and "What does this mean? on a separate sheet of paper twice. Write it out start to finish or beginning to the end.
- 5. Write boldly/largely, "I believe in God the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth," on their triangle on one side.
- 6. Go to page 109, in your <u>Small Catechism</u>. Read question #96, "Why is the First Person of the Trinity called "the Father?" Write two reasons.

- A. What are your thoughts on racism?
- B. Why is racism sinful and against God's Word?
- C. Write out one verse from Bible verses #321-#324, that they believe speaks the most clearly about racism and why they chose that verse.
