Lesson 19: "The Apostles' Creed, Part 6," (L18)  
Year 1 (7<sup>th</sup> Grade)

After completing this lesson, the student will:

- \*Know details about Christ's Second coming and the meaning of The Parable of the Ten maidens/virgins.
- \*Can share details about Christ's return.
- \*Understand how redemption refers to them specifically.
- \*Can share that when they speak the Creed it's a statement of which they say, "This is most certainly true."

1. Introduction:

Watch video: (Parents are to meet with students during instruction with this commandment).

2. Students are to get their second triangle, "God the Son." Add to that "God the Son" Triangle as you deem fit over this class.
3. Write on a piece of paper or a marker board, "The end." What does this mean when one sees it? The book or TV Show or movie is over and there is no more to come, it's time to come home. As God created the world, there will be an end time when Christ returns. For everyone it is the end of their earthly world, it's over! For believers they will be taken to be with their Lord in paradise and eternal life. God has never failed one promise and He won't fail with this promise, "He shall come again to judge the world."
