1. Introduction:

Watch video: (Parents are to meet with students during instruction with this commandment).

2. Grab a bill or an IOU. Then hold up some money and/or a check book. Do any know what these are? These are things we have to pay. We pay by a check or sometimes with cash. Sin is the evil things we do. What are some sins that you and I commit? Due to sin against God, we ow Him a debt. As a matter of fact, sin is also called a debt and in the Lord's Prayer, some say "forgive us our debts and we forgive our debtors." Let's say I owe someone a thousand dollars and can't afford to pay them back. But let's say that the person or institution that I owe the debt forgives me and releases me? That would be grace and gracious. Today, we hear about the part of the <u>Third Article of the Apostles' Creed</u> that God forgives sin. He wipes out our debt. Not with money, but with His son's life and death and blood. Today we hear of the <u>"Forgiveness of Sins!"</u>
