It's meant for those learning and growing in the basics. The Gospel of Luke is an overview of Jesus written for those unfamiliar with the entire story of Jesus. It was written by a doctor to a person of some acclaim, Theophilus, about the account of Jesus life. Luke embraces all core concepts about Jesus and his key events in Jesus' life. Luke's account forms a good foundation to understand the rest of Scripture.
