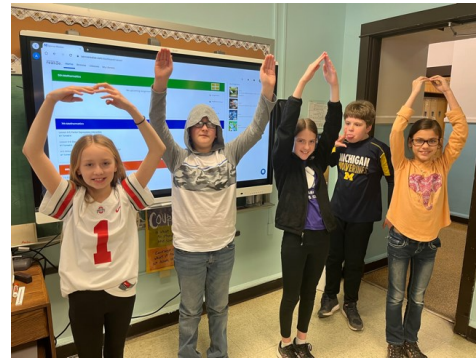
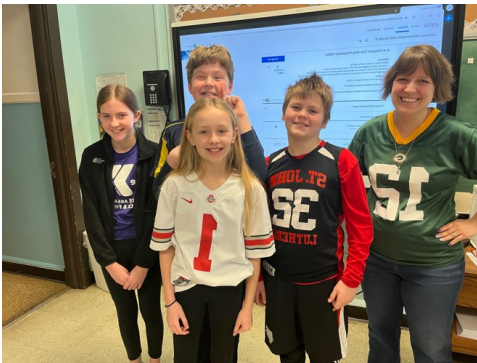

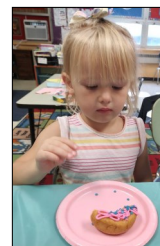
**April's BLAST event** on Wednesday, April 26th from 6:30-8pm is planned to be an ice cream party with games, so mark your calendars!

This class is currently working through The Prodigal God, Recovering the Heart of the Christian



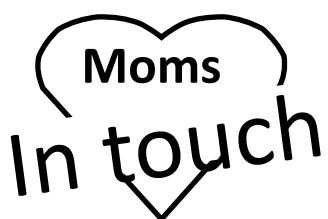

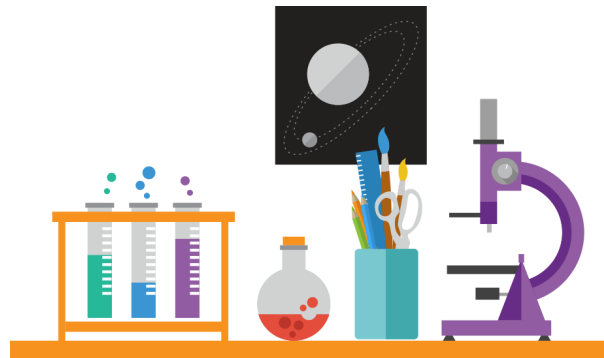


## GREETINGS FROM SCIENCE CLASS!

## St. John Lutheran Clothes Closet Highlights for 2022

The Clothes Closet continues to be a valuable outreach ministry for the Defiance Community. During the past year. Approximately 65 families got clothing and household items because of financial need or circumstances. Many church members help with sorting, pricing, organizing, and selling of clothes, household items, and toys.

About \$17,500 was generated from the selling of good-quality, reasonably-priced items. Money raised from the Clothes Closet helps to fund numerous projects for St. John Lutheran Church and School and community needs. Here is a list of some of those projects.

\$6,000 for Missions

\$300 for Staff Retreat

\$125 for Early Childhood Conference

\$500 for operation K.A.V.I.C.

\$346 for Preschool Bibles



In addition, the Clothes Closet pays the church around \$2,500 for all the utilities for the year for the property where the Clothes Closet is located.

The Clothes Closet is always accepting donations. We especially need men's and children's clothing and household items.

The Clothes Closet is located across the street from St. John Lutheran Church. You can bring donations to the back door from 8-10am on Monday and Tuesday, or during business hours: Thursday 9am-4pm and Friday 10am-2pm.

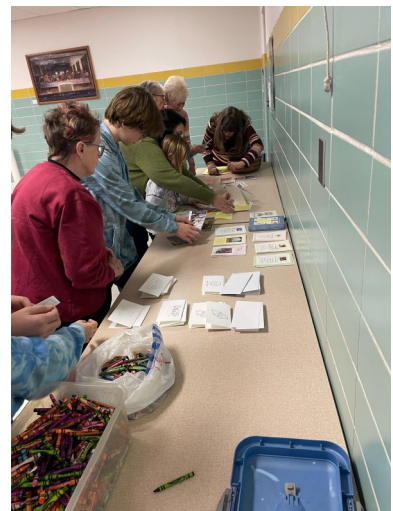
As of Tuesday, February 21 we served 49 families or 144 people. We distributed 211 bags of food for a value of \$2110. Thank you for your continued support.
